COMMON TERMS

- Weather/ Climate/ Atmospheric conditions
- Pollution/ Contamination
- Biodegradable Substance/object that can be decomposed by bacteria or other living organisms, thereby avoiding pollution
- ① Drought* a prolonged period of abnormally low rainfall, leading to water shortage
- ① Floods overflow of large amounts of water, beyond its normal limit
- ① Heatwave a prolonged period of abnormally hot weather
- ① Deforestation clear (an area) of/ remove forests, trees
- ② Eco-friendly not harmful to the environment
- Haze blurring of the atmosphere, typically caused by suspended particles like smoke or vapour BR (vapor AM)
- ① Mist >>> Fog water droplets obscuring visibility
- ② Storm strong winds and usually rain, thunder, lightning, or snow
- ① Blizzard a severe snowstorm with strong winds
- ① Fertilizers chemicals added to soil/ land to increase its fertility
- ① Pesticides substance to destroy insects or organisms harmful to plants or animals
- Breeze light wind
- # Hurricane a storm with a violent wind
