To have much luggage on you/to have just a carry-on on you

Comfy "walking shoes"/flats – удобная обувь для прогулок/обувь без каблука

Statutory/tasteful clothes

To stock up on something – закупиться чем-л

To stay at a bed and breakfast (мини-отель, гостиница с системой «постель и завтрак», пансион)/youth hostel (общежитие) Half board (includes breakfast and dinner) - полупансион

Full board (includes breakfast, lunch and dinner) – полный пансион

Amenities – удобства, условия отдых, оснащенность отеля, коммунальные удобства, комфортабельность

A room with a bathroom (en suite) (в номере)/with a shared bathroom (общая ванная)/with an ocean view/with a street view A single/double (с двуспальной кроватью)/twin room (с 2 односпальными кроватями)

To rent an apartment/cottage

To charge smb for smth (снимать плату за что-то)/to overcharge smb/to charge your credit card

Travel Idioms

- at a good clip and *at a fast clip rapidly. (*Typically: go ~; move ~; run ~; travel ~.) We were moving along at a good clip when a state trooper stopped us.
- **in a body** *Fig.* as a group of people; as a group; in a group. (*Typically: **arrive** some place ~; **go** ~; **leave** ~; **reach** some place ~; **travel** ~.) The tour members always traveled in a body.
- off the beaten track and *off the beaten path Fig. away from the frequently traveled routes. (*Typically: be ~; go ~; travel ~.) We found a nice little Italian restaurant off the beaten track.
- **travel light** to bring very few things with you when you go on a trip My new car has lots of cargo space, which is great for people like me who don't travel light.
- Fifth wheel (USA) A fifth wheel is something unnecessary or useless
- **Hit the road** When people hit the road, they leave a place to go somewhere else.
- get on your bike. get moving.
- Norman Tebbit told the unemployed of Britain to get on their bikes and find work elsewhere.
- To be in the same boat. To be in the same situation (usually unpleasant) as other people.
- She's always complaining that she has too much work, but we're all in the same boat.
- **Hit and run**. This idiom describes a road accident in which the driver who caused the accident drives away without helping the other people involved and without telling the police.
- "The police are hunting a hit and run driver."





- Make a U-turn Change your mind
- · He's made a decision already and I can't see him changing his mind. He's not the kind to make a U-turn
