

Prejudices that fret our lives.

A *prejudice* is a prejudgment: i.e. a preconceived **belief**, **opinion**, or **judgment** made without ascertaining the facts of a case. It also means <u>a priori</u> beliefs (without knowledge of the facts) and may include "any **unreasonable attitude** that is unusually **resistant to rational influence**.
