

Social problems

Social issues are matters which directly or indirectly affect a person or many members of a society and are considered to be problems, controversies related to moral values, or both.

The needy – нуждающиеся

The poor - бедные

The miserable - нищие

Poverty/abject poverty/bitter poverty/grim poverty/grinding poverty/ - бедность; крайняя бедность; ужасная нищета; беспросветная бедность; тяжелая нужда;

To live in poverty

Poverty-stricken - бедствующий

A neighbourhood that reeks of poverty – район неприкрытой нищеты

To be reduced to abject poverty – впасть в крайнюю нищету

To plunge smb into poverty – довести к-л до нищеты

To be thrown into poverty – впасть в нищету

To condemn smb to a life of poverty – обречь кого-то на жизнь в нищете

To be spurred by poverty to commit a crime – совершить преступление из-за нищеты

Homeless people

To commit suicide/to make away with one's life/to do (make) away with oneself/lay hands on oneself/put an end to one's life/take one's own life/end one's life/ shut one's lights out

Nursing homes/rest home/care home/senior centre – дом престарелых

To use/to recourse to corporal/physical punishment – использовать физическое наказание

To discipline one's children – воспитывать детей

Heavy-handed/rigid/severe/iron/strict/stern discipline – жесткая дисциплина

Loose/lack of discipline – разболтанная дисциплина, недостаток дисциплины

To keep/maintain/loosen/ensure/teach smb to discipline – сохранять, поддерживать, ослаблять, обеспечивать, приучать к-л к дисциплине

- as luck would have it -к счастью или к несчастью; как повезёт; как получится
- to be back to square one начинать все сначала

Now that this chemical spill has wiped out the creek's salmon and trout populations we're back to square one. It's going to be very difficult to re-establish fish population. - придётся всё начинать сначала

- start from scratch начинать с нуля; начать на голом месте; начать все с самого начала
- born yesterday наивный, доверчивый; как будто только вчера на свет родился
- calm before the storm затишье перед бурей
- last-ditch effort последняя попытка
- look before you leap семь раз примерь, один отрежь
- every dog has its day будет и на нашей улице праздник
- cut to the chase перейти к самой сути, если короче, ... (Well, to cut to the chase ... Если короче, ...)
- I beg to differ позволю себе не согласиться
- my two cents мои пять копеек

часто используется в интернет-форумах и сопровождает небольшое дополнение к большому ответу на вопрос. Напр: Вставлю и свои пять копеек: That's just my two cent's
